

Mercer Street Friends Food Bank Send Hunger Packing Program



Many school age children live in homes where there is insufficient income and resources to adequately feed the family. The School Breakfast and Lunch programs provide meals for these children during the week. Over the weekend the children often do not get enough to eat and go hungry.

In partnership with the elementary schools in Mercer County the Food Bank has started the Send Hunger Packing Program. School counselors identify students in need and provide them with packages of kid friendly, easy—to—open and nutritionally sound food to get them through the weekend. The Food Bank provides the food.

- Juice Boxes (100% fruit juice)
- Raisins (individual boxes)
- Toothpaste (toothbrushes not needed at this time)
